## Call for an experienced researcher to assist to the project implementation phase and particularly to the Deliverable D5.2.2 Future Trends Workshop

Public Opinion Research Unit at the University of Macedonia Research Institute launches a Call for an experienced researcher in order to coordinate, organize, schedule and participate to the Deliverable D5.2.2 Future Trends Workshop for the purpose of the Interreg IPA – CBC "Greece – North Macedonia" 2014-2020 Beln Project. More specifically the experienced researcher will be responsible for all the coordination cycle or the workshop that is estimated to take place in November 2023 in Thessaloniki.

- **Participate to the workshop**. The researcher is responsible for preparing a 15' intervention relevant to the topic of the workshop.
